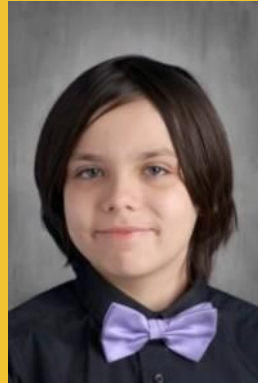

October Titan Big 3 Award

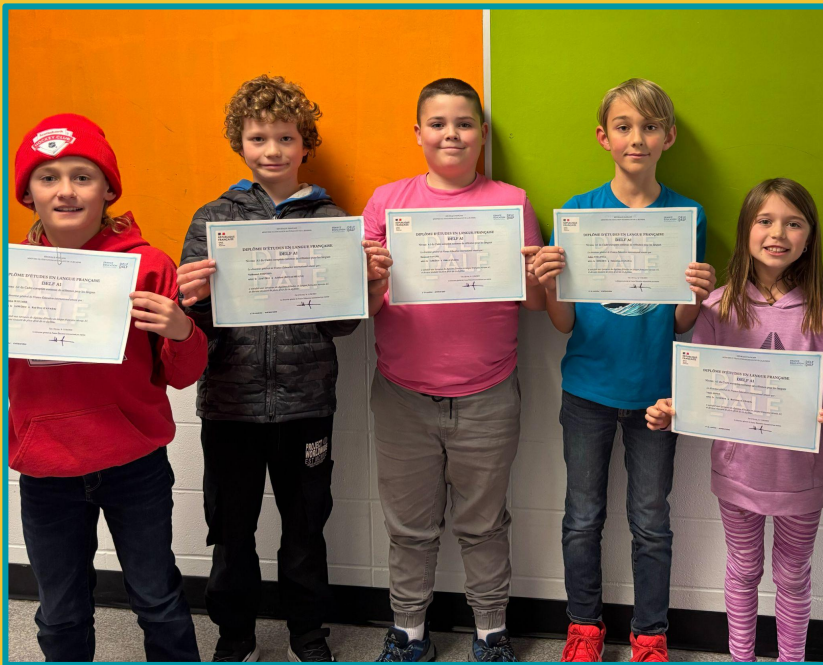
